WATER INDUSTRY ACT 1991, SECTIONS 7 TO 9**

**Variation of the Appointments of
Three Valleys Water plc and Anglian Water Services Ltd as water undertakers**

Made on 17 August 2004

Coming into effect on 20 August 2004

1. Three Valleys Water PLC (“Three Valleys”) and Anglian Water Services Ltd (“Anglian”) hold Appointments as water undertakers for their respective areas (“the Appointments”).¹ The areas to which the Appointments of Anglian and Three Valleys as water undertakers currently relate (“Water Supply Areas”) are set out in their Instruments of Appointment.
2. The site which is shown edged and hatched red on the plan attached to this variation (“the Site”) is within Anglian’s Water Supply Area. The Site is owned by Fairfield Redevelopments Limited and Bedfordshire County Council and is known as Fairfield Park and Lower Wilbury Farm.
3. Three Valleys has applied under section 7(4)(b) of the Water Industry Act 1991 (“the Act”) for a variation of its Appointment to include the Site and a consequential variation of Anglian’s Appointment.
4. On 27 June 1995, the Secretary of State for the Environment and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly and pursuant to sections 6(1) and 7(2) of the Act authorised me to make variations such as those contained in paragraph 5 below. After public consultation as required by section 8 of the Act, I have decided that I should grant Three Valleys’ application without modification.
5. Therefore as provided by sections 7(2) and 7(4)(b) of the Act and with the written consent of Fairfield Redevelopments Limited and Bedfordshire County Council

I vary

- (i) Three Valleys’ Appointment as a water undertaker, so that the Site is included in Three Valleys’ Water Supply Area.
- and
- (ii) Anglian’s Appointment as a water undertaker, so that the Site is excluded from Anglian’s Water Supply Area.
