

2014-15 Special Agreement Register: Northumbrian Water Ltd

Special Agreement Information

Potable Water

There are no special agreements for potable water supplies.

Non- potable Water

NESNONPOT1

An historic agreement agreed in 1952 that was brought into the appointed business regulated by Ofwat on 1 April 2001. The agreement terminated on 30 September 2012.

NESNONPOT2

This is an agreement with a golf course which takes untreated water from bore holes no longer used by Northumbrian Water. It started on 30/03/00 and is due to expire on 29/03/21. The charge varies in line with RPI.

NESNONPOT3

This is an agreement with a golf course which takes untreated water from bore holes no longer used by Northumbrian Water. It started on 3/10/01 and is due to expire on 2/10/21. The charge varies in line with RPI.

Sewerage

There are no special agreements for sewerage.

Trade Effluent

NESTE2

This is an inherited agreement established in January 1969 to run for an indefinite period. First 45,000 gallons/day (202.5m³/day) not charged. Standard rates apply to any additional volumes.

NESTE3

This agreement allows for use and maintenance of effluent overflow tanks. It was established in April 1971 but was extended in October 2010. This agreement was ended in March 2014.

NESTE7

Agreement originally agreed in November 1998 to run for seven years and terminate in September 2005, but was extended until 31 March 2014. The agreement involved the provision of transfer and the biological treatment of raw and virgin liquors for the removal of a high ammonia load. The charges are cost reflective, taking into account the flow, load and treatability of the effluent concerned.

NESTE8

This agreement commenced in July 2001 and will run for fifteen years. It involves the provision of transfer and the biological treatment of process effluent for the removal of chloride and sulphide. The charges are cost reflective, taking into account the flow, load and treatability of the effluent concerned; it also reflects the cost of capital.

NESTE9

This agreement commenced in March 2003 and will run for 15 years. The agreement involves the provision of transfer and the biological treatment of process effluent for the removal of COD. The charges reflect the cost of providing the services; this includes the cost of the capital investment.

NESTE10

This agreement commenced in September 2002 and will run for 15 years. The agreement involves the provision of transfer and the biological treatment of process effluent for the removal of COD. The charges are cost reflective, taking into account the flow, load and treatability of the effluent concerned. Also reflects the cost of capital.

NESTE11

This agreement commenced on 1st July 2004 and will run until 30th June 2029. Agreement involves the provision of transfer and the biological treatment of process effluent for the removal of COD. The charges are cost reflective, taking into account the flow, load and treatability of the effluent concerned. Also reflects the cost of capital.

NESTE12

This agreement was terminated in July 2012. The agreement involves the provision of a long sea outfall for the customer to discharge his effluent. Also reflects the cost of capital.

NESTE14

This agreement, commenced in April 2010, will terminate in March 2020. It involves provision of pre-treatment, transfer and the biological treatment of an acidic effluent stream for the removal of BOD. Charges are cost reflective, taking into account the flow, load and treatability of the effluent concerned. Also reflects the cost of capital.

Bulk Supply Information

Exports of Water

NESBSE1

This supply is to Affinity Water. It was agreed prior to privatisation to run indefinitely and relates to an obligation under the South Essex Waterworks Act 1935. It is charged on the basis of Essex & Suffolk's standard volumetric tariff (Essex charging area).

NESBSE2 – NESBSE7, NESBSE11

These supplies are to Anglian Water. They are historical agreements, which date back to an obligation under the South Essex Waterworks Act of 1935 and the subsequent Hanningfield Water Order of 1950. A reciprocal agreement exists on similar terms. A netting-off of revenue therefore takes place. The agreements stand until either party considers that it is appropriate to renegotiate the terms due to a material change in circumstances.

NESBSE9

This supply is to United Utilities. It was agreed in 2003 to run for 20 years. It is charged on whichever of Northumbrian Water's standard metered tariffs is appropriate for the volume supplied.

NESBSE12

This bulk supply to SSE Water was agreed in June 2011. It has no end date. It is charged on whichever of Northumbrian Water's standard metered tariffs is appropriate for the volume supplied

Sewerage services supplied

There are no arrangements for the supply of bulk sewerage services to any appointee.

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
