Special Agreement Information

Potable Water

BRLPOT - Various

These small agreements were made between landowners and the local councils and water authorities at the beginning of the 20th Century. Typically, they allowed a limited supply of water in exchange for access rights. These agreements were taken on by Bristol Water from the 1950s, when it acquired the small water authorities. There are currently 31 such supplies, totalling around 86 Ml per year and revenue of £100,870.

Non-potable Water

BRLNONPOT2

This agreement commenced in 1975, and was revised in April 1993. The customer receives both potable and non-potable supplies. Standard large user tariff applies, but with an 8% reduction for the non-potable supply.

Exports of Water

BRLBWE2

This minor supply is to Wessex Water and is charged at Bristol Water's standard major user Band G rate.

BRLBWE3

This is a free supply to Wessex Water. It was agreed in August 1984 to terminate in August 2054.

BRLBWE4

This bulk supply is to Wessex Water and commenced in 1973, for a period of 50 years. It has an annual fixed charge and a volumetric charge that increases in accordance with the daily average consumption. This daily average is calculated over a period of one month.
