

2016-17 Special Agreement Register: Bournemouth Water

Special Agreement Information

Potable Water

SBWPOT1

This agreement is for a cross border supply for a dual filtered supply of water. It was agreed on 1 April 2013 and will remain in force until 31 March 2016. It has separate tariffs for non-potable industrial and potable use which are subject to annual RPI-based adjustment. Supply can be partially constrained during peak months but there is provision for a peak tariff for volumes taken above the constraint level. The current contract has been extended for 2 months pending the results of a retender process.

Non-Potable Water

SBWNONPOT1

This is an agreement introduced for river augmentation. No charge is made for the supply of water as it is for purely environmental reasons.

Supplies/services provided to other Appointees

Exports of Water

SBWBWE1

This was agreed in March 1967 to provide a small supply to a rural part of Wessex Water's area. It was terminated in March 1997. Since that date no formal agreement has been in place, but Bournemouth Water has continued to supply on an informal basis when the need arises. However from 1st January 2016, any supplies will be charged at standard tariffs.

SBWBWE2

Reciprocal resilience agreement with Wessex Water signed in August 2013 for a period of 25 years.
