

## **2016-17 Special Agreement Register: South West Water Ltd**

### **Special Agreement Information**

#### **Potable Water**

##### **SWTPOT2 to SWTPOT66**

There are 60 supplies that are provided under pre-privatisation agreements. They all run indefinitely with the exception of SWTPOT9 and SWTPOT13 which run for 2000 and 998 years respectively. The volume supplied in 2014-15 was just over 131.1MI; the resulting revenue was around £112,201.

#### **Non-potable Water**

There are 6 supplies that are provided under pre-privatisation agreements. They all run indefinitely. The volume supplied in 2014-15 was just under 1.2MI; the resulting revenue was around £901.

#### **Sewerage**

##### **SWTSEW6**

The documentation for this on-going pre-privatisation agreement is missing. The customer receives a 75% reduction on the standard tariff for the purpose of fire-fighting requirements.

##### **SWTSEW8**

The documentation for this on-going pre-privatisation agreement is missing. The customer does not pay sewerage charges for the volume recorded by a sub-meter on the customer's property. On the remaining volume supplied, the customer pays sewerage charges on the basis of a 67% return to sewer allowance.

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### **SWTSEW9**

The documentation for this on-going agreement is missing. The customer only pays sewerage charges for the volume recorded by the main meter minus a sub-meter. It is likely that this agreement dates from before privatisation.

### **SWTSEW10**

The documentation for this on-going agreement is missing. The customer pays charges for wastewater for a maximum of 13m<sup>3</sup> of water that passes through a 25mm meter. It pays standard charges for water passing through a 15mm meter. It is likely that this agreement dates from before privatisation.

### **SWTSEW12 – SWTWES75, SWTWES77 - SWTSEW83**

All these agreements end on 31 March 2017. The customers pay the normal standing charges, but lower volumetric rates apply to reflect the reduced strength of the wastewater from the properties.

### **SWTSEW76**

This agreement started in August 2002. The customer receives a discount of £14,000 per annum off the standard sewerage charges in return for an initial investment. The agreement will be renegotiated in 2023.

### **SWTSEW90**

This agreement started in August 2013 and will run for five years. Effluent is discharged directly to sewage treatment works. R charge is reduced by 21% as a result.

### **SWTSEW91**

This agreement started in April 2000 and will run until 31 March 2107. Lower volumetric rate applies to reflect reduced strength of the wastewater from customer's property.

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**SWTSEW92**

This agreement started in April 2001 and will run until 31 March 2017. Lower volumetric rate applies to reflect reduced strength of the wastewater from customer's property.

**Trade Effluent**

No special agreements exist for trade effluent services.

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## **Supplies/services provided to other Appointees**

### **Exports of Water**

#### **SWTBWE1, SWTBWE2**

These potable bulk supplies are to Wessex Water. There are no formal agreements in place.

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
