Background

As part of the detailed works undertaken by MOSL and its IT system developer 35 specific defects with the system have been identified. These defects fall within CSD201, 206, and 207.

The modification proposal¹

MOSL proposed WRC037 to amend 35 small defects which known to MOSL during testing of the Central Market Operating System.

This proposal was consulted on with 4 responses from both Water Only companies and Water and Sewage companies responding. All supported the change.

Interim Code Panel recommendation

At its meeting on 14 June 2016, the Interim Code Panel voted unanimously to recommend WRC037. Minutes of the meeting indicate Panel considered the change to positively impact on the efficiency of the code².
