Environmental Information Regulations –Request For Information

Dear

Thank you for your request for information concerning:

the number of houses using septic system of sound construction: either a septic tank, or a cesspit or pool within the UK.

I write to confirm the information you have requested is not held by Ofwat. Ofwat does not hold information on the numbers or locations of households served by spetic tanks, cesspits or cesspools.

Infrastructures such as these are required to have a permit and it is possible that the Environment Agency may hold the information you have requested.

Ofwat has only ever collected information on the number of billed properties for the sewerage service and the total connected population.

In the 1990's there was some information indicating that the percentage of households (or population) not connected to mains sewerage in England and Wales is around 4%. While populations have grown, at a national level the proportion connected to mains sewerage seems not to have varied much through the 1990's and in all probability has not changed much since.
