Competition law guidance consultation

We are writing in response to the above consultation.

We note the responsibilities of companies summarised in Section 1.4 of the document along with the range of options that are available to Ofwat in order to bring an investigation to a conclusion, summarised in Section 2.6.

It is helpful to have confirmation as to Ofwat's approach to market definition (set out in section 3.3 of the document). We note (in Section 2.6) that Ofwat may issue guidance in the form of an opinion and believe that it would be of considerable benefit to the sector if Ofwat could offer a fuller opinion as to the definition downstream retail market. In particular, it would be helpful for the following statements to be expanded such that there is greater clarity as to Ofwat's view of both the service and geographical dimension of the non-household retail market: "... where some retail markets are open to competition and others are not, and differences exist on the basis of geography, it may be appropriate to draw a distinction between customer groups" and "if a large customer is located near a boundary with another water company, it might be reasonably served by both. In such a case, we might include both companies in the relevant geographic market".
