Thank you for your email in which you request information concerning Faversham Sewage Works

Ofwat confirms it does hold some of the information requested.

The information Ofwat holds in relation to Faversham Sewage Works is statistical data dated 2011 from our June returns. Please see document attached. The table shows us that in 2011 Faversham was a secondary biological treatment works and was serving a population equivalent of approximately 33,000 people (as opposed to households). Since 2011 we have not collected or held updated data. As Faversham is a relatively large site, its discharge will be monitored under the EU Urban Wastewater Treatment directive which requires regular flow monitoring and effluent sampling, at least once a month. The Environmental Agency (EA) will report on whether it is meeting its consent and will take action which can include a hefty fine if it is not. The EA will also log any pollution incidents that relate to the site.

Most of the information you have requested will be reported to the EA by the water company and held on their public register. The EA have a search facility, although for some of the details you have requested there may be a specific request that you

have to put in and wait for the data, rather than it all being something you can readily view on line.
