I write to confirm that the information you have requested is held by Ofwat.

Ofwat is the economic regulator for the water industry in England and Wales. The duties for most of our work as an economic regulator are laid down in section 2 of the Water Industry Act 1991 (WIA91) as amended. The legislation can be viewed [here](#).
