Thank you for your request for information concerning biogas data. As the economic regulator Ofwat does not collect biogas statistical data, but there is some useful information on the Anaerobic Digestion & Bioresources Association (ABDA) site at this link <http://adbioresources.org/map>. You can use the search facility to filter sewage sludge plants only and for each site there is information about electrical capacity (for those with Combined Heat and Power (CHP) engines) or biomethane production capacity in (m<sup>3</sup>/hr) for those that direct gas into the gas grid. As an example see the screen shot attached.

The water companies themselves may also hold data themselves but you would need to direct your request to them directly. If the information is not published on their websites you can submit an EIR request to them as they are subject to the Environmental Information regulations 2004 and will need to confirm if they hold the data or not.

I hope this helps with your enquiry.
