Trading and procurement codes – consultation on updating our guidance

Thank you for providing us with the opportunity to comment on the updated guidance for company trading and procurement codes.

Q1: Do you support the new requirements or principles we have set out in section 2.2?

Yes, we support the proposed changes set out in Table 2 of the consultation document.

Q2: Do you support our proposed approach to approving new codes, as set out in section 2.3?

Yes, we support the changes proposed for the approval of new codes. We agree it is right to maintain a period of public consultation to ensure equal treatment of those who have already published codes and maintain transparency.

The reduced timescales that you have set out for public consultation and the ability for automatic code approval in the event that no consultation responses are received will bring greater efficiency to the process.

Q3: Do you support our proposed approach to updating approved codes, as set out in section 2.4?
