

**WATER SERVICES REGULATION AUTHORITY
WATER INDUSTRY ACT 1991, SECTIONS 7 TO 9**

Variation of the Appointment of Wessex Water Services Limited as a Water Undertaker and Termination of the Appointment of Cholderton and District Water Company Limited as a Water Undertaker

Made on 30 April 2018
Coming into effect on 1 May 2018

1. Wessex Water Services Limited ("Wessex Water") has applied for a variation of the area for which it holds an appointment as a water undertaker to include the whole of the area for which Cholderton and District Water Company Limited ("Cholderton") is currently the water undertaker ("the Cholderton Area").
2. Cholderton has consented for the purposes of section 7(4)(a) of the Water Industry Act 1991 ("the Act") to the variation described in paragraph 1 and to the consequential termination of Cholderton's appointment as a water undertaker.
3. On 27 June 1995, the Secretary of State for the Environment and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly and pursuant to sections 6(1) and 7(2) of the Act authorised the Director General of Water Services¹ to make appointments and variations such as those contained in paragraphs 4 and 5 below.
4. Therefore, as provided by sections 7 to 9 of the Act, the Water Services Regulation Authority **varies** the appointment of Wessex Water as a water undertaker so that it also applies to the Cholderton Area ("the Variation").
5. In consequence of the Variation, the Water Services Regulation Authority **terminates** the appointment of Cholderton as a water undertaker.
