it may be helpful to view the water resources market information published by the 17 largest water companies. Ofwat's Water resources market information guidance requires those companies to "publish a WRZ boundary file that can be imported to a Geographical Information System (GIS) (such as an ESRI Shapefile)".

"A list of more recent area changes (such as where specific sites have been included or excluded from a water supply area or a sewerage services areas) is included at the beginning of our working consolidated versions of each water company licence."

Companies have been publishing their water resources market information on their websites alongside their draft water resources management plans (WRMPs). This includes GIS shapefiles of their water resource zones (which are used for water resources planning purposes), consistent with their WRMP. We have collated the links to the relevant water company webpages where this market information is published on our website <https://www.ofwat.gov.uk/regulated-companies/markets/water-bidding-market/water-resources-market-information/>.
