We've now launched our consultation on changes to the way we charge for new connections from 1 April 2020.

We want to know your opinions on how we implement charging rules from our regulator Ofwat, which affect all water and wastewater providers. Among other changes, the rules mean that from 1 April 2020 asset payments will disappear.

We're hoping for as much feedback as possible from the self-lay sector – so please click on the link below and let us know your thoughts.

The consultation is being run independently, so any responses you provide will be anonymised.

Please tell us your views by Monday 30 September, when the consultation closes.

As we highlighted in our update last week, Water UK have launched their final



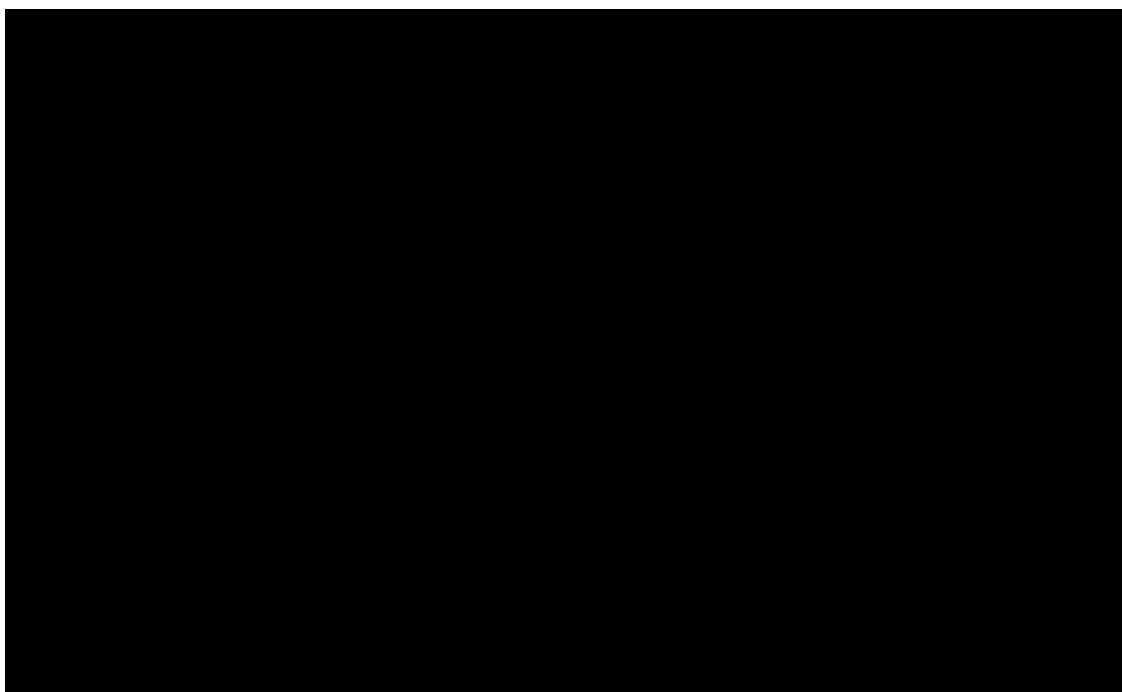
consultation on the planned Code for Adoption for water assets.

The industry association is seeking feedback on drafts of the two documents that will make up the Code: the Sector Guidance and the Adoption Agreement.

It's the last chance to comment before the launch of the Code – on a date yet to be announced – so we encourage anyone with an interest to take part. The consultation closes at midnight on Wednesday 18 September.
