

**WATER SERVICES REGULATION AUTHORITY**  
**NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF THE WATER SUPPLY LICENCE AND**  
**SEWERAGE LICENCE OF NWG BUSINESS LIMITED**

**This Notice of Revocation is given to NWG Business Limited by the Water Services Regulation Authority, revoking Water Supply Licence number 010/2016/WL and Sewerage Licence number 009/2016/SL, with effect from 20 March 2020.**

**Whereas:**

On 30 September 2016, the Water Services Regulation Authority (“**Ofwat**”) granted a water supply licence with a retail and a restricted authorisation to NWG Business Limited (Water Supply Licence number 010/2016/WL) under section 17A of the Water Industry Act 1991 (“**WIA91**”);

On 30 September 2016, Ofwat granted NWG Business Limited a sewerage licence with a retail authorisation (Sewerage Licence number 009/2016/SL) under section 17 BA WIA91 (together “**the Licences**”);

The Licences are subject to the Standard Licence Conditions issued by the Secretary of State under sections 17H and 17HA WIA91;

On 17 March 2017, the Secretary of State issued a general authorisation to Ofwat to revoke water supply and sewerage licences. The general authorisation came into effect on 1 April 2017; and


Standard Condition 11 provides that in issuing a notice of revocation, Ofwat must set out the matters it relies on to justify the revocation and the date the revocation will take effect. It also provides that the revocation may not come into effect until 30 days after the notice is issued, except in certain circumstances, including where the licensee consents to the revocation.

**Now therefore:**

**Ofwat hereby revokes NWG Business Limited’s water supply licence and sewerage licence, relying on Standard Licence Condition 10(2)(a), as NWG Business Limited has consented to the revocation.**

**The revocation of the Licences will take effect 20 March 2020.**
