Thank you for providing the opportunity to respond on the draft proposals to refine the interim supply process. We welcome the efforts within the proposed changes to ensure sufficient flexibility of the interim supply process and the improved clarity. Having reviewed the consultation we did not feel it necessary for us to respond to this consultation.

In reviewing the proposals we did spot what appeared to be an incorrect reference. On page 28 of the consultation it is suggested that section 10.1.4 of the WRC: Schedule 1, Part 2, Business Terms would be deleted, the wording suggests that this should have read 10.1.14.

The changes are aimed primarily at improving consistency between the ISC and WRC and also include some process changes.
