# Variation of Icosa Water Services Limited's appointment to include Barum Knoll, Barnstaple, Devon

On 8 June 2023, Ofwat began a <u>consultation</u> on a proposal to vary Icosa Water Services Limited's ("**Icosa Water**") appointment to become the water and sewerage services provider for a development in South West Water Limited's ("**South West Water**") water supply area and sewerage services area called Barum Knoll, Barnstaple in Devon ("**the Site**"). Details of the application and our assessment of it were set out in the consultation document.

The consultation ended on 7 July 2023. During the consultation period, we received a response from South West Water to the consultation, which is summarised in Section 1 of this document.

Ofwat has engaged with the Environment Agency as part of the application process. For this application, the Environment Agency has flagged that the water supply and demand forecasts in Icosa Water's application do not reflect the assumptions set out in its draft Water Resources Management Plan (the statutory water resources management plan water companies are required to prepare to set out their planning approach for at least the next 25 years), and that this could pose a potential risk of a supply deficit in the future. Where a risk of deficit exists, applicants are expected to assure the Environment Agency, via statutory processes, that there is not a risk of deficit or, that any deficit will be resolved. The risk has been flagged to Icosa Water to action. The Environment Agency has confirmed to us that it is comfortable for the variation to proceed ahead of those discussions being concluded.

We will only make an appointment or variation if our assessment concludes that the application meets the criterion it has been made under; that customers or future customers on the site will be no worse off than if the site had been served by the existing appointee; and if the applicant will be able to finance the proper carrying out of its functions as a water and sewerage company. As set out in our consultation we are satisfied this is the case. The response we received to the consultation has not changed that view.

Having assessed Icosa Water's application and having taken account of the response we received to our consultation, we decided to grant a variation to Icosa Water's area of appointment to allow it to serve the Site for water and sewerage services. This appointment became effective on 28 July 2023.


## 1. Responses received to the consultation

We received a response to our consultation from South West Water. We considered this response before making the decision to vary Independent Water Networks' appointment.


### South West Water

#### WATER SERVICES REGULATION AUTHORITY

#### WATER INDUSTRY ACT 1991, SECTIONS 6 TO 9

#### Variation of the Appointments of Icosa Water Services Limited and South West Water Limited as Water and Sewerage Undertakers

#### Made on 27 July 2023

Coming into effect on 28 July 2023

- Icosa Water Services Limited ("Icosa Water") and South West Water Limited ("South West Water") hold Appointments as water and sewerage undertakers for their respective areas ("the Appointments").<sup>1</sup> The areas to which the Appointments of Icosa Water and South West Water as water and sewerage undertakers relate ("Water Supply Area" and "Sewerage Services Area") are set out in their Instruments of Appointment.
- The site called Barum Knoll, Barnstaple, in Devon which is shown edged in red on the plan attached to this variation ("the Site") is within South West Water's Water Supply Area and Sewerage Services Area. The Site is being developed by BDW Trading Limited.
- Icosa Water has applied under section 7(4)(b) of the Water Industry Act 1991 ("the Act") for a variation of its Appointment as a water and sewerage undertaker to include the Site and for a consequential variation of South West Water's Appointment to exclude the Site.
- 4. On 27 June 1995, the Secretary of State for the Environment and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly and pursuant to sections 6(1) and 7(2) of the Act authorised the Director General of Water Services<sup>2</sup> to make variations such as those contained in paragraph 5 below. After public consultation, as required by section 8 of the Act, the Water Services Regulation Authority has decided that it should grant Icosa Water's application.
- Therefore, as provided by sections 7(2) and 7(4)(b) of the Act, and with the agreement of BDW Trading Limited, the Water Services Regulation Authority varies-

- (a) the Appointment of Icosa Water as a water and sewerage undertaker so that the Site is included in Icosa Water's Water Supply Area and Sewerage Services Area; and
- (b) the Appointment of South West Water as a water and sewerage undertaker so that the Site is excluded from South West Water's Water Supply Area and Sewerage Services Area.
