Variation of Icosa Water Services Limited's appointment to include Keyford Meadows, Frome, Somerset

On 2 May 2023, Ofwat began a <u>consultation</u> on a proposal to vary Icosa Water Services Limited's ("**Icosa Water**") appointment to become the water and sewerage services provider for a development in South West Water Limited's ("**South West Water**") water supply area and Wessex Water Services Limited ("**Wessex Water**") sewerage services area called Keyford Meadows, Frome, Somerset ("**the Site**"). Details of the application and our assessment of it were set out in the consultation document.

The consultation ended on 31 May 2023. During the consultation period, we did not receive any representations.

We will only make an appointment or variation if our assessment concludes that the application meets the criterion it has been made under; that customers or future customers on the site will be no worse off than if the site had been served by the existing appointee; and if the applicant will be able to finance the proper carrying out of its functions as a water and sewerage company. As set out in our consultation we are satisfied this is the case.


Having assessed Icosa Water's application and having received no responses to our consultation, we decided to grant a variation to Icosa Water's area of appointment to allow it to serve the site for water and sewerage services. This appointment became effective on 15 August 2023.


Variation of Icosa Water Services Limited's appointment to include Keyford Meadows, Frome, Somerset

WATER SERVICES REGULATION AUTHORITY WATER INDUSTRY ACT 1991, SECTIONS 6 TO 9

Variation of the Appointments of Icosa Water Services Limited, South West Water Limited, and Wessex Water Services Limited as Water and Sewerage Undertakers

Made on 14 August 2023

Coming into effect on 15 August 2023

- Icosa Water Services Limited ("icosa Water"), South West Water Limited ("South West Water") and Wessex Water Services Limited ("Wessex Water") hold Appointments as water and sewerage undertakers for their respective areas ("the Appointments"). The areas to which the Appointments of Icosa Water, South West Water and Wessex Water as water and sewerage undertakers relate ("Water Supply Area" and "Sewerage Services Area") are set out in their Instruments of Appointment.
- The site called Keyford Meadows, Frome in Somerset, which is shown edged in red on the plan attached to this variation, ('the Site') is within South West Water's Water Supply Area and Wessex Water's Sewerage Services Area. The Site is being developed by The Curo Group.
- 3. Icosa Water has applied under section 7(4)(a) of the Water Industry Act 1991 ('the Act') for a variation of its Appointment as a water undertaker, and under section 7 (4)(b) of the Act for a variation of its Appointment as a sewerage undertaker, to include the Site and for a consequential variation of South West Water's and Wessex Water's Appointments to exclude the Site.
- 4. On 27 June 1995, the Secretary of State for the Environment and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly and pursuant to sections 6(1) and 7(2) of the Act authorised the Director General of Water Services' to make variations such as those contained in paragraph 5 below. After public consultation, as required by section 8 of the Act, the Water Services Regulation Authority has decided that it should grant Icosa Water's application.

¹ Bristol Water's and Wessex Water's original Appointments as water and sewerage undertakers were made by the Secretary of State for the Environment under sections 11 and 14 of the Water Act 1989, now replaced by sections 6 and 11 of the Water industry Act 1991. Losa Water's original Appointment was made by the Water Services Regulation Authority under sections 6 and 11 of the Water industry Act 1991. "With effect thron 1 April 2005 the functions of the Director General of Water Services were transferred to the Water Services Regulation Authority in accordance with section 36 of, and Schedule 3 to, the Water Act 2003.

- Therefore, as provided by sections 7(2) and 7(4)(a) and 7(4)(b) of the Act, and with the agreement of The Curo Group and South West Water, the Water Services Regulation Authority varies-
 - (a) the Appointment of Icosa Water as a water and sewerage undertaker so that the Site is included in Icosa Water's Water Supply Area and Sewerage Services Area;
 - (b) the Appointment of South West Water as a water undertaker so that the Site is excluded from South West Water's Water Supply Area; and
 - (c) the Appointment of Wessex Water as a sewerage undertaker so that the Site is excluded from Wessex Water's Sewerage Services Area.
